We are offering some new options this year which include five-day a week classes and a new half-day kindergarten class. Our kindergarten class will be taught by a fully licensed kindergarten teacher and will follow a curriculum that aligns with DCSD kindergarten curriculum. Our half-day program will have a maximum of 12 children which will allow students a lot of one-on-one time with their teacher and assistant teacher to help them better develop their reading, writing, and beginning mathematical skills. Students will be fully prepared to enter first grade upon completion of our kindergarten class.
