The Pumpkin Patch!

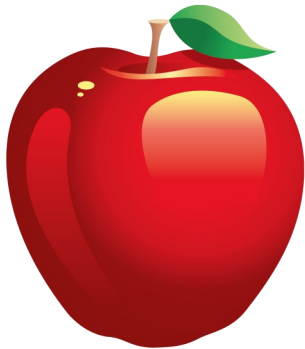
